



## Audition Information 2019-2020

### I. **WARM-UP** - April 18, 2019 @ 4:30 p.m.

The candidate must arrive by 4:30 to check in, start individual warm-up, and receive an audition number. The director will be making note of who is and who is not warming up. This can affect your score.

### II. **APPLICATION AND CONTRACTS – DUE DATE:** Thursday, April 18, 2019 by 4:30 p.m.

- A. Resume with 8x10 headshot attached to the back of the resume.
- B. Application with candidate and parent signatures.
- C. Audition Acknowledgement Form
- D. Social Media Contract signed by candidate and parents.
- E. Current Report Card
- F. Parent Expectations Contract
- G. You may submit your documents early.

### III. **TRYOUT ELIGIBILITY**

- A. The candidate must attend and stay for the entire audition process. Failure to do so will result in candidate ineligibility.
- B. Candidates must have passed four (4) out of the 6 Six Weeks.
- C. All forms must be turned in on or before the due date. If forms are incomplete the candidate will not be allowed to tryout.
- D. **NO** forms will be accepted after **4:30 pm** of audition date.
- E. If a student receives an INC for the 5<sup>th</sup> six weeks, the candidate will have until April 25 to complete all work missed.
- F. Candidates must have an acceptable disciplinary record and be cleared by their corresponding principal.
- G. Unacceptable disciplinary record includes but is not limited to; excessive absences, ISS placement, dress code violation, bullying, unacceptable social medial posts, disrespecting of teachers, staff, or administration, school suspension.

### IV. **Audition Process-** April 18, 2019 -Woodrow Dance Studio

- A. During the audition, the candidate will take a short ballet class and learn a modern/contemporary phrase.
- B. All candidates must wear a solid color leotard with tights, ballet slippers for ballet, and NO shoes for modern. No booty shorts. No revealing clothing.
- C. Hair should be worn in a bun. No exceptions. Failure to do so will result in candidate being ineligible for the audition.
- D. No jewelry. This includes facial piercings, earrings, gauges, naval piercings.
- E. Short, manicured nails. Clear nail polish is acceptable. No acrylic nails.
- F. No gum chewing.

G. Audition process is CLOSED to the public. Only candidate, directors, administration, and judges are allowed.

## **V. AUDITION ATTIRE**

- A. Black or solid color leotard, tights, optional ballet skirt, ballet slippers.
- B. No booty shorts or soffee shorts.
- D. Hair should be worn neatly in a bun. You should not have to mess with your hair during the tryout process at all.
- E. No jewelry whatsoever.
- F. Make-up should emphasize your individual features (smoky eye shadow, mascara, eye liner, blush, and lipstick).
- H. No glitter eye shadow, hair gel, or body glitter.
- I. Neatly manicured nails. ONLY clear nail polish is acceptable. No acrylic nails.
- J. No gum.

## **VI. Audition Process**

- A. Auditions will be held on Thursday April 18, 2019 starting at 5:00 p.m.
- B. Professional dancers will evaluate the candidates.
- C. Candidates will receive a number as they check in/register determine audition order.
- D. Tryouts are closed to the public. Only the directors, candidates, judges, and administration may be present.
- E. Candidates must stay until the end in case the judges need to see them again.
- F. Results will be posted by their numbers outside the dance studio. Results may also be posted online via the organizations social media.
- G. A candidate may view their individual results the week after tryouts. Candidates are not allowed to view another candidate's results.
- H. Candidates parents may make an appointment to view their child's individual scores. Parents nor candidates are allowed to photograph nor receive a copy of the judges scores.
- I. All decisions are final.
